2018 Bluejacket-Flint Fun Run Fall Fundraiser

Dear Bluejacket-Flint Families and Friends,

Every fall, the PTA sponsors one large fundraiser and this year we are hosting a FUN RUN! Student participants have the opportunity to raise money in a healthy way by walking/running to reach their goal. All students will participate during their gym class the week leading up to our Fun Run. They will have 20 minutes to complete as many laps as they can around a 1/5th mile track. Students will collect pledges/donations from family, friends or neighbors to support their efforts. Donors can pledge a flat donation amount in support of the student. We will then gather together for the Fun Run finale at the school on **Saturday, October 6th at 9:00 am*** to cheer everyone on and walk/run the final half mile lap.

How do I get pledges?

Ask friends and family!! It takes just minutes to set-up your child's fundraising page at https://pledgestar.com/bluejacket/ and begin requesting pledges, or you can use the form on the front of the pledge envelope. When participants request pledges from at least 10 people online, they will be eligible for a special prize. Pledges can also be turned in by cash or check. Please collect the cash or check donations and turn in to the school in the pledge folder with your students name on it.

- Go to http://pledgestar.com/bluejacket
- Click "Not Registered For This Year's Event"
- Enter your name and email address, then click "Submit"
- Follow the instructions on-screen to register students

When you finish, the system emails pledge requests to your family and friends, and allows them to make secure credit card donations online. You get notified each time a pledge is made, and you can track your pledge progress online. Call 1-888-598-7510 if you need help.


What is the goal?


